**Kuldip Singh J.(Oral)**

Petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No. 463 dated 6.11.2014, under Sections 406,420,467,468,471 and 474 of Indian Penal Code, P.S. Sector-39 Chandigarh. Suffice to record that petitioner was the President of Sartaj Co-operative Housing Society. The allegations against him are that being the President of said society embazzled more than 8 crore rupees of the said society. Further allegations against him are that three persons were authorised to deal with the bank, however, he forged the resolution authorising himself alone as the person authorised to deal with the bank which facilitated the embazzlement. It is stated that the entire record is with him. Keeping in view the seriousness of the allegations, I am of the view that free hand should be given to the police to investigate the scam properly. It is alleged that there are more than five FIRs against the present petitioner.

No ground to grant anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
