INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioners Nirmal Singh, Bahadur Singh, Lachman Dass and Jaswinder Singh have preferred this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.175 dated 15.11.2014, registered at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Mohali), under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 474, 120-B IPC.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

The petitioners have already joined the investigation. Petitioner Nos.1, 3 and 4 are stated to be the attesting witnesses of the sale deed. There is no dispute regarding the fact that anybody has impersonated in place of someone. The main liability of the witnesses is only to identify the persons but there is no dispute regarding the identity of the persons. As regarding the

allegation against petitioner No.2, he is a property dealer and there are no allegations against him that he has prepared the forged death certificate of Dayal Singh or forged certificate of the Sarpanch. No useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 23.12.2014, passed by this Court, granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.
