Counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are being harassed by the police officials of Police Station City Moga. On the application filed by the petitioners, vigilance inquiry has been started against some of the official(s) posted in Police Station City Moga. It is further submitted that even if the petitioners' son is involved in criminal cases, falsely lodged against him, the police has no right to cause harassment to his family members. The petitioners submitted a representation dated 17.11.2014 to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga for taking action against official respondents No.5 & 6 but to no result.

Without meaning to express any opinion in regard to involvement of son of the petitioners in criminal cases, the petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga to look into grievance of the petitioners only qua alleged misconduct of the police official(s). However, nothing stated in this order shall be construed to restrain the police from taking action against the petitioners or their family members, in accordance with law, if they have committed any cognizable offence.
