This is a petition for quashing of an FIR on the basis of compromise.

Report has been received that none of the parties turned up to make statement regarding compromise before the Illaqa Magistrate.

Since the petitioner is a proclaimed offender, no ground is made out for quashing the FIR on the basis of compromise. It will be open to the petitioner to challenge the order declaring him proclaimed offender or to surrender before the Illaqa Magistrate and file a fresh petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.
