This is a petition for quashing the non-bailable warrants which were issued on 12.09.2014 (Annexure P-3).

It is not disputed that on 12.09.2014, the petitioner was in custody and could not appear before the trial Court since he was not produced by the Police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that though the petitioner was released on 18.09.2014, yet could not appear on the next date i.e. 01.11.2014 since non-bailable warrants were issued against him and undertakes to now appear before the trial Court and furnish fresh bail bonds.

Learned Deputy Advocate General, on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh, has fairly stated that he would have no

objection to the prayer being allowed provided the petitioner appears on the next date i.e. 21.08.2015.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
