This order shall dispose of aforesaid two petitions i.e
CRM No. M-43220 of 2014 filed by Kapoor Singh and others and
CRM No. M-43221 of 2014 filed by Roshan Lal and another.

2. CRM No. M-43220 of 2014 has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.37 dated 22.05.2013, under Sections 326, 324, 323 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Kotbhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3).

3. CRM No. M-43221 of 2014 has also been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of cross-version case registered as Rapat No.26, dated 22.05.2013 in FIR No.37 dated 22.05.2013, under Sections 323, 324 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Kotbhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib (Annexure P-1), as well as all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3).

4. Reports of learned trial Court have been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that both the parties have effected compromise with their own free will and without any pressure or coercion of any kind. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which stood amicably settled.

5. In view of the above, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

6. Consequently, both petitions are allowed and FIR No.37 dated 22.05.2013, under Sections 326, 324, 323 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Kotbhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib as

well as Rapat No. 26, dated 22.05.2013 and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom including cross-version case are quashed qua the petitioner(s).
