This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a criminal complaint No.36 dated 06.09.2013 under Section 302 read with Section 34 of IPC pending in the Court of Judicial Magistrate First Class, Ludhiana.

As per the allegations, the present petitioner had killed his brother of respondent No.2 namely Jagdish Chand Sharma on account of property dispute with the help of co-accused Suresh Sharma. The death is stated to have been caused by administering poisonous substance. The petitioner has been summoned to face a trial by the learned Judicial Magistrate, vide order 07.08.2014 (Annexure P-2).

The FIR No.87 dated 06.08.2011 (Annexure P-3) was

registered by the co-accused Suresh Sharma against the complainant/respondent No.2-Ajay Sharma @ Sony under Section 306 IPC for which after presentation of the challan charges have been framed and the trial is in progress. With regard to the same incident the present complaint has been filed.

In compliance of the order dated 22.12.2014, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court on 07.01.2015 and the trial Court has accepted his bail bonds.

In view of above, no further orders are required to be passed and the order dated 22.12.2014, passed by this Court is made absolute. The petitioner will be bound by the conditions of the bail.

Disposed of accordingly.
