HARI PAL VERMA J.

Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 482 of the Criminal Procedure Code, for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioners, especially from respondents No.2 and 3 and their associates.

In response to the notice of motion, the State has filed reply by way of affidavit of Harvinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Rural, District Hoshiarpur on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Police has recorded the statement of the petitioner No.2, namely, Anu Rana in which she has stated that she was born on 12.09.1992, and has done 10+2 and GNM Course. She solemnized the marriage on 16.12.2014 with Manish Chandla son of Surinder Pal Singh, r/o District Hoshiarpur. She further stated that though they have filed petition in this Court for protection of their life and liberty, but nobody have interfered in their marriage life, and need no police protection as there is no danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

In view of the fact that there is no emanating danger to their life and liberty, the present petition is disposed of without going into the validity of the marriage.

Disposed of accordingly.
