The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 21.03.2014. While dismissing the earlier application for regular bail, liberty was given to the petitioner to approach this Court after recording the statement of Davinder Singh.

Perusal of the orders passed by the trial Court from 19.08.2014 till 02.12.2014 reproduced in the ground for bail indicate that neither any prosecution witness is being produced by the prosecution agency nor the trial Court is taking effective steps to examine the witnesses and the case is being adjourned casually.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the complainant is not produced by the prosecution agency by 06.04.2015, the trial Court shall release the petitioner on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction.
