C.R.M No.6590 of 2015

For the reasons recorded, the application is allowed subject to all just exceptions. Compromise dated 27.04.2014 is taken on record.

C.R.M-M-4326-2015

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the official respondent to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners as they are alleged to be harassed and threatened by respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned counsel has argued that in this connection the

petitioners have also moved representations (Annexures P-3 & P-4) to the respondent No.2 and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and decide his representations within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2-the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar is directed to look into the matter/representations (Annexures P-3 & P-4) and take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
