REKHA MITTAL, J.

Counsel for the petitioner states that FIR No. 76 dated 17.9.2014 for offence punishable under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 has been registered against him in Police Station City Mansa. The petitioner made a representation to the Director General of Police, Punjab dated 01.10.2014 (Annexure P2) for fair investigation in the crime at the behest of local police.

Without meaning to express any opinion on merits of the allegations raised by the petitioner, the petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Director General of Police, Punjab to look into grievance of the petitioner and dispose of his representation within 15 days from the receipt of certified copy of the order. However, nothing stated in this order shall be construed to restrain the police from taking action against the petitioner if he has committed a cognizable offence.
