INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to conduct proper and impartial investigation in case FIR No.71 dated 20.10.2014, registered at Police Station Old Shalley, Gurdaspur, under Sections 326, 325, 341, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 326 and 325 IPC added lateron) and to submit report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner only prayed that the concerned Investigating Officer be directed to expedite the investigation.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

The FIR in the present case has been registered on 20.10.2014. The petitioner has also approached the learned

Magistrate for issuance of direction to SHO to conduct the investigation properly. The challan has not been presented so far, as stated by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, the concerned Investigating Officer is directed to expedite the investigation.

With the aforesaid direction, the instant petition stands disposed of.
