RITU BAHRI, J.

This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C is for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R No. 17 dated 22.01.2014, under Sections 399, 402, 420, 465, 468, 471, 411 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station, City Ropar, District Rupnagar.

As per the allegations in the FIR, on 22.01.2014, a police party headed by Inspector/SHO Manvir Singh, Police Station City Ropar, received a secret information that the present petitioners along with other persons, armed with deadly weapons, were present at Transport Nagar, Rupnagar and they were planning to commit a dacoity. Thereafter, the petitioners along with other persons were apprehended.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that co-accused of the petitioners have already been granted bail by this Court.

Heard.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioners

and the fact that the trial may still take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioners any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be enlarged on bail subject to furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Rupnagar.
