Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the Appellate court to decide the application for compounding expeditiously.

Notice of motion only to respondent No.2.

Mr. Ramesh Dhiman, Advocate has entered appearance on behalf of respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in this case the parties had compromised the matter at the appellate stage and moved an application for compounding in July, 2015 and the same has not yet been decided and therefore a direction may be issued to the Appellate Court to

decide the same expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, a direction is issued to the Appellate Court to decide the said application expeditiously but in any case within 2 months.

Petition stands allowed in the above terms.
