HARI PAL VERMA J.(Oral)

Petitioners have approached this Court for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners as they apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents.

Notice of motion only to respondents No.1 to 4 at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Shaveta Sanghi, AAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner

No.1 had moved a representation dated 17.12.2015 (Annexure P-5) to the Supereintendent of Police, District Karnal but no action has been taken on the said representation so far.

Without commenting on the contents of the aforesaid representation, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Karnal, to consider and decide the said representation in accordance with law.
