Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered on the basis of a secret information to the effect that the petitioner was found in possession of 300 kg of poppy husk contained in 10 bags along with two other accused Malkiat and Ashok @ Sukha. Petitioner was allegedly found driving the vehicle.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 7.6.2013. The bail has been sought inter alia on the ground that all the witnesses stand examined and the case is fixed for defence evidence and final argument for today.

Taking into consideration the stage of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to refer to the merits to appreciate the strength of the evidence against the petitioner.

The petition is dismissed on account of trial having reached at penultimate stage.
