Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing the FIR No. 70, dated 18.08.1998, under Sections 323, 341 and 506 IPC, Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar (**Annexure P-1**), as also the order dated 27.11.2003 (**Annexure P-2**), passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Jalandhar, declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender and all other subsequent proceedings arising from the above said FIR.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order dated 16.07.2015, passed in CRM-M No. 547 of 2015, the above said FIR has already been quashed on the basis of compromise. As such, the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
