Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.8, dated 18.11.2014, under Sections 323, 324, 336, 34 IPC and 25, 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Rangar Nangal, District Batala along with cross version registered vide DDR No.21, dated 19.01.2014 (Annexure P/2) in the aforesaid FIR and all the consequential proceedings emanating out of the aforesaid FIR and the cross-case on the basis of compromise.

At a stage when challan had not been presented, parties having compromised, under the directions of this Court, have appeared before the Area Magistrate and got their statements recorded. A report has been received to the effect that the matter has been compromised without any threat, pressure or coercion.

In view of above circumstances, following the judgment of Full Bench of this Court in case ***Kulwinder Singh***

and others Vs. State of Punjab, 2007(3) RCR (Crl.), 1052, this petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR as well as the cross case recorded in the above said FIR and all the subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to a condition that all the petitioners will deposit a total sum of Rs.5000/- with the Punjab State Legal Services Authority, Sector 22, Chandigarh and another total sum of Rs.5,000/- with Punjab Police Welfare Fund, Sector 9, Chandigarh ,within a period of one month.
