1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?
2. To be referred to the Reporters or not?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

At the very outset, learned counsel states that in the array of parties the description of respondent No.2 has inadvertently been mentioned as Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar instead of the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar and prays that the same may be corrected.

Allowed as prayed for. Registry is directed to make necessary correction in the array of parties.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Voter Identity Card (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 11.07.1995 whereas petitioner No.2 has placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2) depicting his year of birth as 1994. They have also moved a representation before the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without advertent to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
