This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing FIR No. 40 dated 17.07.2014 under Sections 148, 323, 326 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise, along with all consequential proceedings arising there from.

In compliance of the order dated 22.12.2014 passed by this Court, Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Kapurthala, recorded the statements of the parties and also recorded his satisfaction that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and solved their differences without any threat or coercion.

Learned counsel for the parties have stated at bar that the matter has been compromised.

So, in view of the above circumstances and in view of authority reported as, “*Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others*” **2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the above said FIR stands quashed. Further proceedings in pursuant to that FIR also stand quashed.
