Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 213 dated 15.11.2014, registered at Police Station Civil Lines Batala, District Gurdaspur, under Sections 406/506/120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 23.12.2014, a Coordinate Bench of this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioners would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in

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connection with above-said case FIR.

On instructions from ASI Nirmal Singh, learned State counsel informs that the petitioners have joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further states that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioners and their custodial interrogation is not required.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that as per his instructions, parties have effected compromise.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 23.12.2014 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
