The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. Praying for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners as they apprehend a threat to the same at the hands of private respondents on account of having entered into matrimony against the wishes of elders.

Notice of motion was issued in the present petition on 10.2.2015 and respondent no.3 was directed to ensure protection of the petitioners in case there is any threat to them at the hands of the private respondents.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Gurbaksh Singh, Police Station, Patti, District Tarn Taran would apprise the Court that statements of both the petitioners have since been recorded and they have stated that they are living happily together and do not require any protection.

This perhaps also explains the non-appearance of counsel for the petitioners.

In view of the categoric stand taken on behalf of the State, no further directions are required to be passed in the instant petition and the same is, accordingly, disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
