As per allegations of the prosecution, the petitioner along with two other co-accused Surjit Singh and Niranjana Singh has tried to run over PRHC Amarjit Singh who was on duty at ATM. As per allegations, two blows were given on his chest. They tried to run their Tata Ace over Amarjit Singh with intention to kill him and in this process, his right arm was struck in angle and they dragged him. The intention of the petitioner is clear in respect of offence under Section 307 IPC. So, the petitioner is not entitled to concession of bail.

When the Court was not inclined to accept the prayer of the petitioner, learned counsel for the petitioner wanted to withdraw the present petition.

The petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
