RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.

In this petition petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.11 dated 13.01.2014 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 380/457/34 IPC at Police Station Passiana, District Patiala along with all subsequent proceedings.

This Court vide order dated 22.12.2014 passed following order:-

"Notice of motion for 17.03.2015.

In the meantime, parties are directed to appear before the trial Court and the trial Court, after recording statements of the complainant/victims, shall send its report

qua the genuineness of the compromise along with copies of the statements.”

In pursuance to the above-said order both the parties appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Patiala and got their respective statements recorded.

Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Patiala has made a report after forming its opinion that the compromise in question is genuine and parties have suffered their statements without any pressure, coercion and undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise, parties are not at *lis* anymore and it would be just and appropriate to quash the proceedings in question.

Resultantly, prayer made in the present petition is allowed and FIR No.11 dated 13.01.2014 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 380/457/34 IPC at Police Station Passiana, District Patiala and all subsequent proceedings undertaken thereof are ordered to be quashed.
