The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 118, dated 05.10.2003 under Sections 307, 353, 332, 224, 186, 148, 149 IPC and Section 34 IPC which was added later on at Police Station Nurmahal, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 22.12.2014 passed by this Court, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court; has deposited an amount of Rs.50,000/- before the trial Court and has also been released on bail.

In view of the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the interim order dated 22.12.2014 passed by this Court is made absolute.
