Petitioner along with Binder Singh had facilitated the release of loan on the basis of fake identity of Balbir Singh as Santokh Singh. Co-accused Binder Singh has been granted the concession of bail. The allegations against the petitioner is that he in connivance with Binder Singh had prepared fictitious voter card, driving licence etc. to facilitate the fraud.

This is second application for bail, first having been dismissed earlier. In the similar circumstances, Binder Singh co-accused of the petitioner has been granted the concession of bail by this Court in CRM-M-1373 of 2014. The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 21.08.2013.

On the principle of parity, he can be granted the concession of bail. Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that in case the petitioner indulges in any similar

activity of which he is accused of, this order will be deemed to have been withdrawn entitling the prosecution agency to arrest the petitioner with intimation to this Court.
