Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are major and there is no legal impediment to their marriage. They have solemnized marriage. Their marriage is opposed by respondent No.4, who is father of petitioner No.1.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State of Punjab. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

Without expressing any opinion with regard to validity of marriage and on the merits of the assertions made in the petition, the

instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, Punjab, to consider and decide the representation-cum-Justice Demand Notice dated 15.12.2015 (Annexure P-5) and provide necessary protection to the petitioners, if he is satisfied that the life and liberty of the petitioners is threatened at the hands of respondent No.4, in accordance with law.
