This is a petition for quashing of FIR No.213 dated 17.10.2014, under Sections 324, 326, 506, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural on the basis of compromise. The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Amrinder Singh alleging that the petitioners armed with different weapons had attacked the complainant.

Parties having entered into a compromise. They were directed to appear before the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ajnala to get their statements recorded and after recording the statements of the parties, the learned Magistrate has sent a report to this Court regarding the matter having been compromised voluntarily, without any threat, coercion or undue influence.

Following the full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to the petitioners depositing a total sum of Rs.10,000/- with Punjab State Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh, within a period of one month from today. The said amount will be sent to All India Pingalwara Charitable Society, Chandigarh Branch, an institution meant for taking care of destitutes.
