The FIR has been registered on 07.05.2015 on the allegations of Manoj Kumar Sharma alleging that he is resident of Delhi and never executed a special power of attorney in favour of anybody but he has come to learn that a sale deed has been registered regarding his land through Dharminder Singh and Manoj Kumar impersonators.

Quashing of FIR, at this stage, has been sought alleging that there is no connection of the petitioner with the FIR. Since the investigation is at initial stage, the role attributed to the petitioner has to be determined as per the material available by the investigating agency.

This petition is disposed of as pre-mature having been filed at a too early stage with liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court again in case the prosecution agency opts to present challan against him.
