The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of the order dated 29.10.2014 (Annexure P-5) passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Nabha, whereby, the petitioner was declared as a proclaimed offender in relation to criminal proceedings arising out of FIR No. 29, dated 09.05.2012, under Sections 323, 324, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Bhadson, District Patiala.

Since this Court vide order carrying even date i.e. 07.04.2015 passed in CRM-M No. 1143 of 2015 has already quashed the FIR in question qua the petitioner on the basis of compromise having been effected between the parties, the instant petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
