The petitioners seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing Complaint No.34 dated 03.07.2014, under Sections 3, 4 and 5 of Schedules Castes & Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and under Sections 323, 341, 452, 506 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance to interim order dated 18.12.2014 passed in **CRM-M No.43263 of 2014**, petitioners have appeared before the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Mukerian on 23.12.2014 and have been released on interim bail.
