Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of official respondents, petitioners have approached this Court, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking directions to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondent No.4 or any other person on her behalf.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that when the genuine grievance of the petitioners was not being redressed by the respondent authorities, he finally approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural)-respondent No.2, by way of a self-contained representation dated 05.10.2015 (Annexure P-9), but the same is also pending decision. He further submits that the petitioners will be satisfied in case the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural)-respondent No.2

is directed to consider and decide their representation, within a reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties at a later point of time, Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural)-respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter, consider the grievance of the petitioners, raised vide their representation dated 05.10.2015 (Annexure P-9) and decide the same, at an early date by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law, but in any case within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
