Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 4 to hand over the investigation of case FIR No.102 dated 10.10.2015 under Sections 302 read with Section 34 IPC as well as Sections 25, 25(1) and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station, Phase-8, District SAS Nagar, Mohali to an independent agency on the allegations that the police is helping the accused.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG,

Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply requisite number of copies of complete sets of the paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

A bare glance of the paper book reveals that the FIR was registered on 10.10.2015 and, therefore, the prayer of the petitioner that the matter be handed over to the independent agency is absolutely pre-mature.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this prayer at this stage.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner has prayed that respondent No.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala be directed to ensure the safety and security of the petitioner, for which he has already submitted a representation dated 30.11.2015 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take note of the contents of said representation and to take appropriate action in accordance with law.
