Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.240 dated 28.09.2014, under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar (Punjab).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the mother of the deceased has submitted an affidavit Annexure P-2 that she was residing in Canada along with her son Gurpreet Singh and daughter Daljit Kaur. Her son Sartaj Singh was residing in their house at Babiyan Shahkot, District Jalandhar. Sartaj Singh was a drug addict and wanted to go abroad. Petitioner had assured Sartaj Singh that he would be sent to Canada. However, she had not paid any money to the

petitioner in this regard. Her son lost his mental balance due to his addiction and had committed suicide, whereas petitioner had no role to play in the alleged offence.

Learned counsel for the complainant-respondent No.2 has admitted the genuineness of affidavit Annexure P-2.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed. In the event of arrest, petitioner be admitted to bail subject to the satisfaction of the Investigating officer. Petitioner shall join investigation as and when required by the Investigating officer and shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.
