This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 233 dated 12.11.2014 under Sections 325, 323, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Moga City, District Moga (Annexure P1) along with consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise.

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga has been received. Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate has recorded the statements of the complainant -respondent as well as the accused – petitioners and has reported that the the parties have voluntarily entered into compromise.

It comes out that respodnent No.2- complainant is none else but wife of petitioner No.1. It is stated that it was basically a

matrimonial dispute. The offences are under Sections 325, 323, 34 IPC.

Keeping in view the near relations between the parties and the fact that they have effected compromise, FIR No. 233 dated 12.11.2014 under Sections 325, 323, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Moga City, District Moga (Annexure P1) alongwith the consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition is accordingly allowed.
