After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the investigating agency/Ilaqa Magistrate. He, however, prays that in case a petition seeking regular bail is moved by the petitioner, same be decided expeditiously.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid. In case any application for regular bail is moved by the petitioner after the surrender, the concerned court shall endeavour to decide the same expeditiously.
