This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 554 dated 8.11.2014 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC registered at Police Station City Palwal, District Palwal (Annexure P1) along with consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 9.12.2014 (Annexure P2).

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Palwal has been received. Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate has recorded the statements of the parties and reported that the parties have effected compromise and the same is voluntarily and without any coercion.

The State in reply which has been filed today has also stated that in view of the compromise, the police has presented the cancellation report.

Perusal of FIR shows that it was a matrimonial dispute.

Since, the parties have amicably settled the dispute, therefore, FIR No. 554 dated 8.11.2014 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC registered at Police Station City Palwal, District Palwal (Annexure P1) alongwith the consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition is accordingly allowed.
