SABINA, J

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.2 dated 04.01.2015, under Sections 420, 419, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Dinanagar, District Gurdaspur.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 20.02.2015:-

“Petitioner seeks concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered at the instance of Hardev Singh alleging that husband of the petitioner Pawan Kumar and his brother in law along with petitioner had brokered a deal regarding purchase of land measuring 8 acres by complainant. The original agreement of sale executed by Rachpal Singh in favour of complainant was retained by the husband of the petitioner. Neither the sale deed was executed nor amount was returned.

It is claimed by the counsel for the petitioner

that petitioner is a house wife. The property transaction, if any, is with her husband Pawan Kumar.

Notice of motion to the Advocate General, Punjab, for 7.4.2015.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the petitioner will join investigation on 7.3.2015. In case of petitioner doing so, she will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Tara Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 20.02.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
