Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.91 dated 22.05.2010, under Sections 304/323/34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar.

Vide order dated 23.12.2014, a Coordinate Bench of this Court directed that in case the petitioners appear before the Illaqa Magistrate within 15 days, they would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the said Court.
