By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail, in case FIR No.47, dated 10.09.2014, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station S.G.N.D. Thermal Plant, Bathinda.

The learned counsel contends that the petitioners are not the signatory to the agreement to sell dated 02.04.2013 (Annexure P1). The agreement to sell was entered into between Lal Chand and son of petitioner No.1 and grandson of petitioner No.2. He further states as against the total amount of Rs.12,50,000/-, an amount of Rs.

8 lacs as settled between the parties in terms of the compromise, has already been paid to the complainant. The FIR (Annexure P-4) stands registered against the complainant and in pursuance of the order dated 23.12.2014, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner have joined the investigation, however, the remaining amount is still to be recovered.

There are allegations and counter allegations and the FIR stands registered against the complainant as well. In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 23.12.2014, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
