By way of first petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.84, dated 13.10.2015, registered under Sections 377/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), Section 66-A/67-B of Information Technology Act, 2000 and Section 4 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offence Act, 2012, at Police Station Jodhan, District Ludhiana Rural.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. There is a delay of 17 days in lodging the present FIR. He further submits that the petitioner had no role whatsoever in the alleged incident.

Heard.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the accusation, no case is made out for bail.

Dismissed.
