JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 52 dated 20.03.2013 under Sections 279 and 337 IPC registered at Police Station, Samrala, District Khanna, on the basis of compromise along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

2. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that compromise was effected between the parties and is outcome of their free will and consent and without any pressure. The same seems to be genuine and volunteer. Even otherwise, matter involved in these proceedings is personal in nature,

which has been amicably put at rest.

3. So, in view of circumstances narrated above as well as the observations made in case reported as **Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another; 2012(4) RCR(Criminal) 543**, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for the benefit of the parties and would certainly bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition is allowed and FIR No. 52 dated 20.03.2013 under Sections 279 and 337 IPC registered at Police Station, Samrala, District Khanna and all other subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom stand quashed qua the petitioner.
