This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 143 dated 27.8.2014 under Sections 406, 420 IPC registered at Police Station Khamano, District Fatehgarh Sahib (Annexure P1) along with consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 18.12..2014 (Annexure P2).

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Fatehgarh Sahib has been received. Statements of the complainant and accused have been recorded. It is reported that the the parties have effected compromise and the same is without any pressure and is genuine. Basically, it was a monetary dispute.

Since the parties have effected compromise, therefore,

FIR No. 143 dated 27.8.2014 under Sections 406, 420 IPC

registered at Police Station Khamano, District Fatehgarh Sahib
(Annexure P1) alongwith the consequential proceedings stands
quashed.

The petition is accordingly allowed.
