The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.166 dated 01.04.2014, registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 506, 419, 420, 170, 171, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, (for short, 'the IPC') at Police Station Hodal, Distt. Palwal.

The learned counsel contends that the petitioner is the father-in-law of the daughter of the complainant. There is no specific entrustment to the petitioner.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel, on

instructions, submits that the petitioner is the chief conspirator, who induced the family of the complainant to marry his son, Brijesh Sharma, projecting him as an Inspector in the Central Reserve Police Force. The petitioner also forged the identity card of his son, Brijesh. During the negotiations of the marriage, the petitioner handed over the photographs showing his son in the police uniform. The co-accused son of the petitioner is yet to be arrested.

Heard.

Keeping in view the above, no case for bail is made out at this stage.

Dismissed.
