The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.166 dated 5.10.2013 under Sections 15, 61, 85 of N.D.P.S Act, registered at Police Station, Ladhawal, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

Alleged recovery from the petitioner as also co-accused is of 14 bags of poppy husk weighing 40 kgs. each. The same would clearly fall under the commercial quantity and the bar under Section 37 of N.D.P.S Act would squarely apply.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from S.I. Swaran Singh would apprise the Court that the trial is now at the advanced stage inasmuch as all the prosecution witnesses have since been examined.

As such, no ground for concession of regular bail is made out.

Petition is dismissed.
