Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for anticipatory bail in FIR No. 36 dated 30.03.2013 under Sections 323, 324 & 307, 342 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Patiala.

It is contended that the petitioner had been found innocent during investigation but she was summoned subsequently to face trial as an additional accused on an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C moved by the prosecution. It is submitted at the outset that no role whatsoever was attributed to the petitioner for causing any injury to Rajatdeep Singh in the

FIR. Pursuant to order dated 24.12.2014 she has surrendered before the trial court. She undertakes to appear on each and every date fixed before the trial court. No recovery has to be effected from her.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from Head Constable Balwinder Singh affirms that the petitioner has indeed surrendered before the trial court on 06.01.2015.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, it is just and expedient to allow this petition. No useful purpose shall be served by taking the petitioner in custody. No recovery is to be effected from her and the trial is in progress.

Interim bail granted to the petitioner by the trial court shall be made absolute subject to her furnishing fresh bail bonds and surety bond to the satisfaction of the learned trial court.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
