This is a petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (in short, "Cr.P.C.") for grant of regular bail in case First Information Report No.88 dated 21.04.2013 under Sections 148, 149, 302, 323, 285, 506, 212, 307 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code (in short, "I.P.C.") and Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Siwani, District Bhiwani.

Precisely, the case of the prosecution was that on 21.04.2013 when complainant Bhal Singh and his brother were cutting wheat crop and their uncle Partap Singh was irrigating the fields, at about 12:30 noon,

paternal aunt namely Guddi, of the complainant alongwith her husband Ram Niwas, sons Jai Bhagwan, Shamsheer alias Narsi and Naresh alias Shunty and 20-25 other persons attacked on them being annoyed of execution of a will by Udmi Ram, his grandfather in favour of his five brothers.

As regards, petitioner Narender alias Sutri, no specific injury to either the injured or the deceased was attributed to him. The co-accused of the petitioner, against whom there were identical allegations, namely Sombir and Ajit were given the concession of bail vide orders dated 28.11.2014 and 15.12.2014 respectively. The trial is still likely to take more time and in view of facts and circumstances noticed above and least any expression may prejudice the case of the prosecution, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
