RITU BAHRI, J.

This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R No. 611 dated 24.11.2009, under Section 379 IPC and Section 4 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, registered at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

In connected case i.e. CRM-M-43808 of 2014, learned counsel for the complainant has placed on record affidavit of Senior Operation and Maintenance Engineer, Northern Region, Pipelines on behalf of complainant-company. Perusal of the said affidavit shows that the present petitioner is facing investigation/trials in 11 cases.

In this case, the petitioner is seeking grant of anticipatory bail on the ground that his name does not figure in the FIR and he has been involved on a disclosure statement made by the co-accused.

The petitioner was declared proclaimed offender on 01.06.2010.

Moreover, pursuant to the order dated 20.01.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioner could not join the investigation as he was already in custody in a criminal case pending in Rajasthan.

In view of the above facts, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
