Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are major and there is no legal impediment to their marriage. They have solemnized marriage. Their marriage is opposed by respondent Nos.6 to 11, who are their family members.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Harsimrat Rai, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State of Punjab and Mr. Yashwinder Singh, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State of Haryana. The complete copy of the paper book have been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

Without expressing any opinion with regard to validity of marriage and on the merits of the assertions made in the petition, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, Punjab and respondent No.3- Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra, Haryana, to consider and decide the representation dated 21.12.2015 (Annexure P-6) and representation dated 21.12.2015 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioners and provide necessary protection to them, if they are satisfied that the life and liberty of the petitioners is threatened at the hands of respondent Nos.6 to 11, in accordance with law.
