ANITA CHAUDHRY, J

The petitioners impugn the order dated 17.04.2015, vide which the revision filed by them has been dismissed. Challenge has also been made to the summoning order dated 05.06.2014, vide the Magistrate has summoned the petitioners.

Heard.

The petitioners have already exhausted the remedy of revision and this petition amounts to filing a second revision which is not permissible. Even otherwise, it is not a fit case to exercise the powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C. A composite complaint containing allegations relating to the occurrence which took place on 30.09.2011 and 22.10.2011. Copy of the MLR dated 30.09.2011 shows that a number of injuries had been received by the complainant. The fact whether this case was registered in order to exercise pressure upon the petitioners who were witnesses in the State case, is a fact to be examined by the lower Court during trial. No finding can be given in the proceedings filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

The petition is dismissed in limine.
